

CSR Research Colloquium – Polychromy & gilding

"Pigments and gold in Gandharan stone and stucco sculptures"

Two years ago, the Italian Institute for the Conservation and Restoration started a new research project on the polychromy and gilding of Gandharan stone and stucco sculptures and on technological and conservation issues.

The project is in collaboration with the Museum of Oriental Art "Giuseppe Tucci" of Rome and the Italian Archaeological Mission in Pakistan. In the last few months this research provided new interesting results in collaboration with other Museums and the Italian Archaeological Mission in Afghanistan.
