A technical meeting will be held at the ISCR on October 4-5 2016 within the European project Nano-Cathedral, aimed at developing new materials, technologies and procedures for the conservation of deteriorated stones of monumental buildings and cathedrals in different climatic and environmental contexts.

The meeting, which will take place around the middle of the project lifetime, will involve all participants to the project. New innovative materials selected and developed for the project will be presented; moreover the experience of the six cathedrals involved in the products testing will be illustrated. Experimental test methods for the control of products efficacy will be presented and demonstrated. Advantages, disadvantages and any problems encountered in their use will be discussed with particular reference to advices for problem solving.

The Nano-Cathedral project has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation program under grant agreement No 646178.
